It is necessary to remove lime scale on a regular basis, every 25 - 50 times you use a full tank of water or at least once a month, especially in areas with hard water. ACCESSORIES The frequency of lime scale removal depends upon the hardness of your tap water and how often you use the steam mop. 225ml The H2O MOP X5<sup>™</sup> uses tap water.
